



TODAY'S MEETING

Today's meeting sees the last racing event on the Scottish motor racing calendar and it is likely to be a fast and furious affair with the racing chasing the failing light of October which is why the 1600 c.c. road saloons are last on the bill. Indeed it could well be that the Abercromby Road Saloons Championship for Road Cars will be decided in that very last race for two have a chance of taking the title: the hard trying Derek Hastings in his Hillman Imp must beat his deadly rival Alastair McCarter in his Mini and win the up to 1300 c.c. class. It should be a midfield highspot in the race. With regular Fiesta driver Iain Gardner withdrawing his entry due to the fact that he is selling his car it also opens out the 1301 to 1600 c.c. class which should provide a cracker of a race to send us off into the gloom of winter.

The Shell Gemini Senior Formula Ford Championship will also be decided today between reigning champion Cameron Binnie with his Van Diemen against Colin Harper with his Swift. Harper has tried very hard this season and through recent years has come right to the fore. If he wins the race he looks like taking the title, whereas Louis Di Resta has now won the Tom Brown Racing Junior Formula Ford Championship for the second time running. This will be the last time this happens for in 1990 no driver will be eligible to win the title more than once.

Today also sees the Historic Car Race which has been a traditional event at Ingliston's closing meeting. This year there is a superb entry whether you like pre-war or post-war racing cars with Keith Schellenberg coming along for the first time in many years with his huge Barnato Hassan Bentley, the second fastest car ever to lap Brooklands and still capable of tremendous speed despite weighing something over two tons! He will have a number of racing Rileys and chain-driven Frazer Nashes against him whilst in front will be the post-war cars with Kirk Ryland's HWM Jaguar a strong favourite though Campbell McLaren will have his ex-Briggs Cunningham lightweight E-type Jaguar out to play against the Jaguar XK120 of John Foster. Ecurie Ecosse patron Hugh McCaig will compete with the Ecurie Ecosse Tojeiro-Buick which sounds wonderful as it accelerates out of the corners so there is a touch of nostalgia for every generation.

In the other classes there is a big field in the Clubmans and Sports Car event with Laurence Jacobsen and Andrew Fletcher out there with their immaculate Chevron B16 coupes, surely amongst the most beautiful cars ever built and Hugh Chalmers driving Laurence Jacobsen's Ecosse which was raced by Ecurie Ecosse during the 1985 and 1986 seasons.

Truly it is a great field for today's meeting and a fitting end to a season of changing fortunes.





FLAG SIGNALS

Races at Inglinton except the Historic Car event, are now started by Red/Green lights over the circuit. But also signalling to the drivers is by the use of flags round the circuit. The meaning of these signals is as follows:

Blue Flag, stationary — Another competitor is following you close by.

Blue Flag, waved — Another competitor is trying to overtake you.

White Flag — A service car or slow moving car is on the circuit.

Yellow Flag, stationary — Danger, no overtaking and slow down.

Yellow Flag, waved — Great danger, slow down, be prepared to stop. No overtaking.

Yellow Flag with Red Stripes, stationary — Slippery surface ahead.

Yellow Flag with Red Stripes, waved — Slippery surface imminent.

Green Flag — All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. It can also be used to signal the start of a warm-up lap.

Red Flag — Immediately stop racing and proceed slowly and with maximum caution to pits or start line obeying marshal's instructions, and being prepared to stop should the track be blocked.

Black Flag at individual marshal's posts. The race has been stopped.

Black Flag with Orange Disc displayed with White Number — A warning of apparent mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. The car concerned *must* call at its pit for repairs on the next lap.

Black and White Rectangular Flag split diagonally and displayed with a White Number — A warning to the driver of the car bearing the number that his behaviour is suspect and that he may be black-flagged on further reports.

Black Flag displayed with White Number — The driver must stop at his pit within one lap of receiving the signal and report to the Clerk of the Course. A penalty of exclusion may be enforced by removing the car from the race by display of the black flag.

Black and White Chequered Flag — End of race or finish.


