



#### TODAY'S MEETING

Today's meeting is for the Fiat Trophy and it is the first occasion that Fiat Auto UK Ltd. have sponsored a meeting here at Ingliston.

Fiat, of course, have a long history of involvement in motor racing going right back to the early days of racing and the Fiat Grand Prix cars. Today the Fiat Uno Turbo is beginning to make a name for itself and of course the Fiat Abarth 130 has also been a regular class winner in the Uniroyal Championship.

Today's meeting sees yet another large entry of cars with close on 150 taking part and the Formula Ford 1600 event, which opens the programme, has underlined again just how popular this class has become. Since the March meeting a number of drivers have come out to race and we are now getting full grids.

At present the MacAndrews FF1600 Championship is being led by Cameron Binnie, last year's champion, but he only has a two-point advantage over Roy Low with Geordie Taylor another four points behind.

In the Tom Brown Racing School Junior Championship Euan Buchan is in the lead by just one point from Fraser Greenwood with Laurie Hughe and Brian Gowans close behind.

The GT class has waned somewhat, but the best entry this year will be out for this event with current Town & Country Car Rental GT leader Brian Fletcher in his Davrian, on the look-out for more points.

The over 1600 c.c. Road Saloon class brings out the usual array of drivers and the car to watch will be Mike Connon with the Martin's Bar




Escort RS as Connon was a very useful driver last season. The likely winner is still the Ecurie Ecosse Post Office Parcels Manta driven by Hugh Chalmers but Tom Bell is close behind with his Chevette.

The Clubmans and Sports Car class is also building up and there is at present a tie for the lead in the Lowland Tyres and Exhausts Championship between John Fyda and Andy Smith, the latter being in the very latest 1987 Mallock Clubmans car. This is a Class B model with the Formula Ford engine in it and it cannot compete in outright pace with Fyda's but the manner in which the Championship is run gives him just as much chance of outright victory than anyone.

The up to 1600 c.c. Road Saloon class will again pit Glen Mortimer and his Avenger with the Fiestas of Alan Keith and Bill Stevens and this looks like being a very open race.

The main race of the day, for the Fiat Trophy, is the round in the Shell Oils FF2000 Championship where all the leading contenders will be taking part led by Tom Brown, a former winner and last year's champion Stewart Roden both of them in Reynards. There will be the debut of another new car at this meeting with the Talon of Lance Gauld and Campbell Chisholm will debut his Swift which should have run at the last meeting. Keep an eye on Neil Cochrane in this event as he seems to have put a lot of his former bad luck behind him.

In the Road Sports Car class Keith Scott will again be having a go with his Rover V8-engined Dutton which went well at the last meeting until it retired from the race. The man who has surprised everyone, however, is Hamish Ogilvie with a brand new and beautifully prepared Caterham 7 and he is maintaining the tradition of Caterhams in this class.

The second round of the Western Automobile Historic Racing and Sports Car class sees yet another mixed bag of cars including Charles Munro with the tiny vixen which is one of the smallest racing cars ever built. If you are a Morgan fan there are three of them taking part including Sir Aubrey Brocklebank from London; but John MacDonald and Brian Hopkins have much more experience of the track. Hugh Chalmers has been entered in Hugh McCaig's lightweight XK120 if it is ready in time and Campbell McLaren has also entered a Jaguar XK120 along with John Foster's model so it helps the timekeepers out as this race is on handicap.

Finally, there is the Modified Saloons and Sports Cars race for the McLaren Homes Championship and in this Ray MacDowall has a one point lead from Iain Gardner and Tom Bell with Walter Robertson in the Ecosse Manta in fourth place.

We hope you will enjoy your meeting and look forward to seeing you again on July 19th when the next Ingliston meeting takes place.






