## Cumming's slowest is the fastest

INGLISTON, Sep 15: Ron Cumming swept away with the GT race at what he claims was his slowest pace this season. It was enough, though, to ease him away from Brian Fletcher and Neil Fisher.

Ralph Hutchinson was under pressure for the first half of the race from Duncan Fisher. Fisher eventually stormed his Imp into fourth after Roddie Paterson retired his Elan.

Lesley Wood made an inauspicious debut in the Clubmans/F2000 understeering into the tyres at Caravan and the race was stopped.

On the restart, Derek Ferguson romped away from Butcher leaving Reg Forrester-Smith a lap in arrears. Bill Carr was third ahead of Mike Upton.

David Finlay won a lights-to-flag victory in the up to 1300cc Road Saloons. His Vauxhall Nova was pushed hard throughout by Richard Dobson, though.

A battle for third between James Ritchie and Andrew McKinna ended when Ritchie retired and James Patrick's Mini was elevated a place.

FF1600 provided the healthiest field of the day. Campbell

Chisholm took command leaving Thomas Irvine to mount an unsuccessful assault on the second-placed Geordie Taylor. There was a fierce battle for fourth. Cameron Binnie held onto it, but he eventually fell prey to Alex Jack.

In his efforts to re-establish his position, Alex Jack vaulted over David Taylor's rear wheel allowing Stuart Thorburn to snatch fourth place from Colin Birkbeck and Binnie.

Neil Gammie boldly grabbed the inside line from leader Angus Gray in the Kit and Road Sports event to set a record lap.

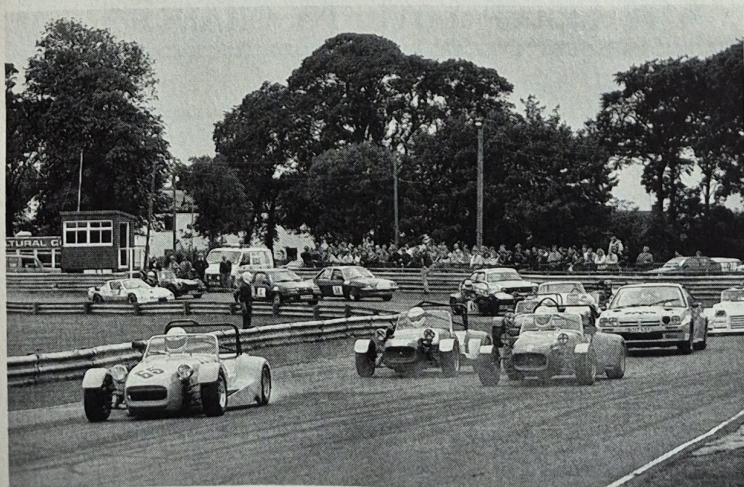
Third placed Alaster Cunningham was chased throughout by Brian Sarafilovic.

Norman Taylor from pole took a close fought victory in the 12-lap 2CV event.

Graham Harper was second and Cameron Ritchie third. Neil McDonald swapped fourth place with Nicholas Runcie until Runcie dropped back, his place taken by Andrew Timpson.

Trakstar series victor David Kerr looked set to improve his points tally in the Road Car Championship as he held off Olly Ross' Nova. But his Fiesta retired in a cloud of oil smoke at half distance, promoting Alan Keith to second.
