





#### TODAY'S MEETING

Welcome to the last race meeting at Ingliston for 1986, but not the last motor sport event for on Monday, 17th November, the RAC Lombard Rally has its final stage of the day within the showground and Park Ferme overnight is in the exhibition hall. Both sites will be open to the public and gates will be open at 5.00 p.m. with the first car over the stage at 7.20. This will be the last chance to see the Group B rally cars competing internationally in Scotland.

Today's meeting sees the final rounds in all the Scottish Championships being run.

The FF1600 entry is as strong today as it has been all season, justifying the sponsorship by both Tom Brown Racing School and MacAndrews for Citroën of the Junior and Senior Championships. In the Junior Championship Alex Knox (62) can only add 8 to his score today with a win so that Angus McPherson cannot be caught even if he scores no points. However, Fraser Greenwood could add a maximum of 10 points to his total so enabling him to catch Alex Knox. The Senior Championship is still open with the top three contenders all able to score up to 16 points today.

#### Today's Meeting - continued


In both these championships points from 16 to 1 are awarded to championship registered finishers from 1st to 16th and the last 7 out of 8 rounds count.
