# **TODAY'S MEETING**

We welcome you today to a much changed Ingliston with no grandstand due to the fact that the Royal Highland & Agricultural Society have been planning to remove the stand for some time. Though a temporary stand will be built for the Highland Show it is not yet known whether we will have grandstand facilities from July onwards.

Today's meeting sees an entry of over 90 cars and at least one new class which is aimed at bringing a bit of additional entertainment to the racing. That class is for Citroen 2CVs and there are seven entries for this first race. Don't expect the outright lap record to go but the cars should be fairly evenly matched with only the experience of the drivers being the important thing. The most experienced is Graham Harper from Glasgow who has been racing down south in the Citroen 2CV series and of the regular Ingliston drivers Andrew McKinna will also be seen with his Suzuki in the road car class.

After a low spell about three years ago Formula Ford has really jumped back and there

are some 23 entries for this meeting.

Already we have seen some interesting changes this year and with Van Diemens having dominated racing in Scotland for a long time the emergence of other makes such as Swift, Mondiale and Reynard is at last changing the picture. Indeed following the recent Knockhill race meeting it was obvious that perennial winner, Cameron Binnie with his Reynard will not have things his own way as both Jim Forsyth with the factory Swift raced by Bernard Dolan and Louis di Resta, two time Junior Champion with the ex-Nico Palhares Van Diemen are going to push him hard. Then there are the teenagers who are now pushing their elders led by Colin Low with his Mondiale and two 17 year old newcomers this year Alex Jack from Bonnyrigg and Jason Yeomans from Kirkcudbright both in Swifts.

This has added a lot of excitement to a class which has always brought excitement to

racing.

There is even more excitement and competition in the 1600cc Road Car Class where the Fiestas are beginning to be challenged by the Toyotas, particularly the lain Cowie car though Gian Pia's Toyota will be running for the first time today and should be interesting. Glen Mortimer took first blood at Knockhill with his Ford Fiesta. The race today is likely to be one of the highlights of the meeting.

Today also sees the return of the Ford Sierra Cosworth in the Road Car Classes and lain Gardner, a consistent winner at Ingliston, will be up against regular winner Alaster

Cunningham who is again out with his Opel Manta.

This year the GT Cars are running alongside the Modified Road cars and Ron Cumming will again be the man to beat. Quite the most fearsome car in that field, however, will be Russell Paterson's TVR S which was specially built for sports car racing with a 500 b.h.p. turbocharged Ford engine. It will not be at its best round Ingliston.

We are looking forward to a good meeting today and remember to mark Sunday May 13

in your diary for the next round in the Scottish Motor Racing Championships.





# **FLAG SIGNALS**

Races at Ingliston except the Historic Car event, are now started by Red/Green lights over the circuit. But also signalling to the drivers is by the use of flags round the circuit. The meaning of these signals is as follows:

Blue Flag, stationary — Another competitor is following you close by.

Blue Flag, waved — Another competitor is trying to overtake you.

White Flag - A service car or slow moving car is on the circuit.

Yellow Flag, stationary - Danger, no overtaking and slow down.

Yellow Flag, waved - Great danger, slow down, be prepared to stop. No overtaking.

Yellow Flag with Red Stripes, stationary — Slippery surface ahead. Yellow Flag with Red Stripes, waved — Slippery surface imminent.

Green Flag - All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. It can also be used to signal the start of a warm-up lap.

Red Flag - Immediately stop racing and proceed slowly and with maximum caution to pits or start line obeying marshal's instructions, and being prepared to stop should the track be blocked.

Black Flag at individual marshal's posts. The race has been stopped.

Black Flag with Orange Disc displayed with White Number - A warning of apparent mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. The car concerned must call at its pit for repairs on the next lap.

Black and White Rectangular Flag split diagonally and displayed with a White Number A warning to the driver of the car bearing the number that his behaviour is suspect and that he may be black-flagged on further reports.

Black Flag displayed with White Number - The driver must stop at his pit within one lap of receiving the signal and report to the Clerk of the Course. A penalty of exclusion may be enforced by removing the car from the race by display of the black flag.

Black and White Chequered Flag - End of race or finish.
