
We blast off today with the Clubmans, and what better ambassador of them than Jim Stevenson's Mallock (30).

#### **FAREWELL, INGLISTON**

At least, as we know it! Yes, Ingliston is again on the move, since over the winter months plans are in hand to extend the circuit, to improve spectator facilities (which ,frankly, are pretty good already!) and to upgrade the circuit for International racing. Naturally the extent and final format of the changes will depend entirely upon financing being available and discussions are in course with a major International sponsor — even if these discussions come to naught there will still be substantial track alterations, but if a suitable sponsorship deal can be finalised, then the dreams of many Scottish enthusiasts may well come true after many years of wishful thinking! Obviously, too, any alterations will require RAC and FIA approval, and today we are delighted to welcome RAC Race Executive, Bob Langford, on his first visit to the Scottish circuit. (If we insist on him wearing a yellow carnation, would all Marshals, competitors and general dogsbodies please prostrate selves and fling fumbs to forelocks on sight — THIS IS AN ORDER!). We sincerely hope that Bob will like what he sees, and we look forward to a fruitful discussion with him afterwards on the question of the RAC's requirements.

Today, in fact, we invite you to wallow in nostalgia. A tear or two, if you may, for the passing of the present layout, and then thrill to the sight, sound and smell of the historic racing cars in one of our best historic grids for many a year. Today's meeting, too, is a memorial to the late John Nicholson, remembered by all enthusiasts as a true Club competitor (in the best sense) before his tragic death. John, in fact, was at the very first Ingliston race meeting in his Lotus 11, and a selection of cars driven by him over his racing career appears on the front cover. The John Nicholson Trophy (last won by Eddie Cheever) will today be presented to the driver putting up the most meritorious drive of the day in the Scottish Championship events.

And what of the Scottish Championships? Today sees the final rounds of each of these, and there are still some cliff hangers for edification. The Dinwoodie Lodge Hotel Championship, for example, where merely a point separates Jim Stevenson (30) and Clive Reeves (38) in their season long battle. Unlike the other Ingliston Championships, 8 out of 10 scores could count here (there were 4 rounds at Donington, remember) and Jim of course has reached his total 41 points from 6 rounds only, which means a win (and a class fastest lap) would give him an extra 8 points. Clive on the other hand, counts 8 to date, and will at best only be able to add 5 points to his score of 42, so on paper Jim Stevenson has everything to go for. But then, nothing comes easily in Clubmans races, as John Barr (26), Paul Gibson (32), Kenny Allen (33) and Andy Smith (34) will testify! Certainly, the recipe for a scorching Haleys Motor Services trophy race.

The current Scottish Championship tables are published on page 3, and as always these give a fair guide to form. It was that form, however, which was upset last September in the 1000 c.c. saloon race, when Jim McGaughay (126) bested Ricky Gauld (132) and both he and Bill Thompson (121) took the fastest laps to underline that what has in the past been a cutthroat class is now positively explosive! Jim and Ricky do battle today for the lead of the 1000 c.c. class (and the Sandy Forrest Trophy), while at the same time Ricky will be mounting a last ditch bid to wrest the Lombard Scottish Saloon Car Championship out of Doug Niven's tenacious grasp. To better Dougal's 36 points, however, Ricky has to both win today's Hope Scott Garage Trophy Race and take the fastest time therein, no mean task up against the local 1-litre cars, with Coventry's Tom Shepard (123) thrown in just to excite matters somewhat! (Due to the number and type of events, and the limitations on daylight hours, there can unfortunately be no saloon cars final today). Current Scottish Champion and current Championship leader, Doug Niven (101), is in an even more invidious position! Should Ricky Gauld manage to score his necessary 8 points, then Dougal will know that , due to the scoring system (and providing there are 3 Championship registered starters in his class — which there. weren't in September!), he will need to better the existing saloon car lap record to retain the Scottish title. And so the results of the first of the two Hope Scott Garage Trophy races will undoubtedly determine the tactics for the seond of the races. That race, too, determines whether either of the 1300 c.c. men lan Forrest (106) and Jim Pimkerton (114) can deny Ricky Gauld of second place in the Championship (if he fails to take the lead), while southerner Peter Baldwin (118) will be fighting out his own personal dice with Ian Forrest. All very good reasons for staying on to the close of play this evening. (And anyway, the Club bar's open afterwards!)

While Stuart Lawson is (again!) the Shell FF Champion, a monumental battle has developed for the runner-up slot, which could be filled by any of David Duffield (60), Keith Lawrence (75) or, after his dramatic win in September, Tom Brown (48). Then again, a win for

either of Cameron Binnie (58) or Dave Manners (63) could, in the right circumstances, hoist one or other of them into 4th position in the Championship, and each driver has both the skill and the machinery to do it. And, while no longer in immediate Championship contention (he, too, can still shoot for 4th place), Roy Low (69) proved himself no slouch last time out!

Modsports is, of course, a straight "top of the class" battle between the all conquering Elan of John Fyda (152) and Brian Stevenson's smaller capacity Davrian (163). John has the edge by virtue of a new lap record (and an extra win) which means that Brian's only hope in today's **Balmoral Hotel, Moffat Trophy Race** is to better the 1300 c.c. class lap record — a record he has already equalled once this year, so it is not as impossible as it sounds. Today's sports car race is given added interest in that it may see the end of regular modified sports car racing at Ingliston. Ten days ago the decision was taken to run a Grand Touring series in 1980 (in which the special saloons and modsports will be intermixed in three separate races — up to 1000 c.c., 1001 - 1500 c.c., and over 1500 c.c. — can you imagine John Fyda v. Walter Robertson, or Brian Stevenson v. Ian Forrest's Impl) and this will fit in well with our commitment to host a round of Donington's £10,000 GT series next year. (Speaking of which, welcome today to the Donington's Bob Fearnell, who is Scotcircuit's guest this afternoon).

To many, the McLaren Builders Historic Car Race is the event of the year, and this afternoon we have a splendid entry to justify that anticipation. In the Pre-War class two regular friends and rivals Ron Footitt (52) and Bill Morris (76) will have no fewer than 4 Fraser Nashes to contend with, while the Post-War brigade will doubtless see the usual scrap between Roddy McPherson (24) and Hugh Clifford's (29) Cooper Bristols, and John Foster's Fisher Riley (23). Space does not permit further discussion, but keep your ear on commentater Jimmy McInnes who will fill you in on the technical data, and your eyes on Keith Schellenberg (66) who will probably narrowly miss filling in every other piece of barrier (if his renouned flamboyent driving style has not changed over the years!). Flamboyent too should be the Wylies Trophy Race for
